#### **More Y3 News**

"In science we have been learning about plants. There are different parts to a flower. The roots anchor the plant into the soil (a bit like a ships anchor). The roots also suck water up like a straw. The leaves make food for the plants, this is called photosynthesis. The stem supports the leaves and takes water from the roots and sends food down the roots. The flower itself makes seeds that are transported to make new plants. The petals attract insects such as flies, bees and wasps."


