Year 4 Swimming


Year 4 will have swimming lessons on a Wednesday morning throughout the 2022-2023 academic year. Please refer to the details on letter emailed out.

Year 6 Skiing


Year 6 will have skiing lessons on a Thursday afternoon throughout the autumn term.


