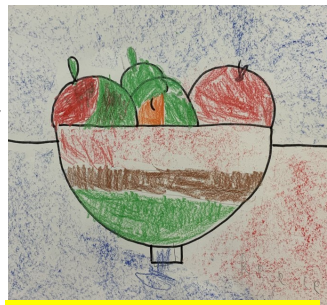
"We painted our favourite book on a plain T-shirt and made a 'Book in a Box' at home. The best part was when we shared our books with all the class."
