Our children on the sacramental programme will receive the sacrament of communion on Saturday 29th June. Mass is at 11am. Please keep the children and their families in your prayers.




School closes on Wednesday 17th July at 3.15pm and re-opens on Tuesday 3rd September at 8.35am in readiness for a 8.45am start.
