


Plans and preparations are well underway for the visits for Years 1,2 and 4. Information will be sent out as soon as details are confirmed.



Transition Day



School closes on Friday 4th April and re-opens on Monday 14th April at 8.35 in readiness for a 8.45am start. (5 day closure)


