

Y1 are currently enjoying Forest School sessions on Monday afternoons.


Reception Class Vision Screening

Our parish charity is open for business.

Opening hours are Tuesday-Friday 10am-4pm, Saturday 10am-1pm, Sunday and Monday closed. Our shop is also accepting donations of goods so please donate when you're having a sort out. Donations can be taken directly to the shop or dropped off at school and staff will take down to the shop. Thank you.

The shop has raised a whopping £9,658.72 for parish funds since it opened at the beginning of July.

Attendance

If your child is absent you must contact school and leave a reason for absence (eg. headache, sore throat etc) on the absence line before 9.00am on the first day of absence. **Thank you to all who already do this. If you fail to do this the absence will be unauthorised. If your child has come home from school, unwell, during the school day and will not be in school the following day, you must still leave a message on the absence line. Thank you to all those who already do this.**

If your child will be arriving to school late, for example, due to medical appointment, again please inform the office. Some parent/carers are sharing this information with their child's teacher on class dojo or verbally which is great, but please ensure the office are informed as they are responsible for documenting the details into attendance registers. Thank you.
