D&T	Workshop- Junk Modelling The children will be learning how to use tools and materials in the junk modelling area. They will be exploring cutting different materials and will plan their own junk modelling creation. They will choose appropriate resources to create their own junk model.	Textiles - bookmarks Available from 7th November 2022. Pupils develop and practise threading and weaving techniques using various materials and objects. They look at the history of the bookmark from Victorian times versus modern-day styles. The pupils apply their knowledge and skills to design and sew their own bookmarks.	Structures-boats Available from 7th November 2022. In this unit, children explore what is meant by 'waterproof', 'floating' and 'sinking', then experiment and make predictions with various materials to carry out a series of tests. They learn about the different features of boats and ships before investigating their shape and structures to build their own.
Music	Celebration music Children will be learning about the music from a range of cultural and religious celebrations, including Diwali, Hanukkah, Kwankzaa and Christmas.	Music and movement Children come up with simple actions to well-known songs, learn how to move to a beat and express feelings and emotions through movement to music.
