

The St. James the Less Lotto Club

OVERVIEW

An opportunity to join the PPTA Lotto Club which involves 59 members and a payment of £1 per week (total 52 weeks). The winner, who receives £30, will be the person who has been allocated the bonus ball number that is picked on the TV in the midweek main Lotto draw. The rest of the funds will be used towards PPTA funding. See Rules and Payment terms below.

RULES

The club shall be run as a private lottery and the sale of the chances will be to members of the St. James the Less PPTA, parents of present pupils, members of the teaching and non-teaching staff and any person wishing to offer appropriate support or help to the school and who is accepted by the Committee as a member.

The designated "promoter" of the lottery shall be the elected Chairperson of the Association.

The price of having the winning chance shall be the same and the payment of that price will be by standing bankers order from the member's bank.

Prizes will only be paid to the owner of the winning chance by the promoter, that being the one who gets the "bonus" ball of the Lotto midweek draw.

No chance may be issued or allotted by the promoter except by way of sale and upon receipt of the full price and no money received by the promoter shall, in any circumstances, be returned.

The membership will be strictly limited to 59 members of the Association on a first come, first served basis, or in multiples of 59 at the discretion of the committee of the PPTA. There will be a reserve list should parents drop out. Places will be filled again on a first come, first served basis.

Payment will be £1 per week paid in advance by standing order. In order to commence in the first draw, on 7th September, instruction for payment should be made by Friday 18th July (end of school term).

There will be weekly draws through the year including holidays (52 weeks). Prize monies will be rolled over on a pro-rata basis should the membership at any time not be fully subscribed. Prizes during school holiday periods will be paid on return to school.

Weekly prize amount awarded = £30

Audited accounts will be available for inspection yearly.
